Tailleurs de père en fils, les Renoma quittent la Pologne en 1936 et s'installent à Paris. Maurice Renoma naît le 23 octobre 1940 et grandit dans le quartier de la rue Notre Dame de Nazareth où ses parents ont monté leur atelier de confection.


Maurice Renoma s'initie au métier de tailleur et crée ses premiers vêtements pour homme dans un coin de l'atelier familial concédé par son père : premiers clients, premiers succès. Création des premiers costumes en alpaga, mohair, flanelle et gabardine et du mythique blazer Renoma deux ans plus tard.
